**Law n° 2014-27 dated 19 June 2014, amending law n° 2009-10 dated 16 February 2009 relating to the national institute of meteorology (1).**

The National Constituent Assembly having adopted,

The President of the Republic enacts the following organic law:

(1) Preparatory works:

Discussion and adoption by the National Constituent Assembly during its session held on 9 June 2014.

Single Article - Is added to law n° 2009-10 dated 16 February 2009 relating to the national institute of meteorology an article one (bis) as follows:

Article one (bis) - Are transferred, as property, to the national institute of meteorology, the buildings and movable property as well as the material belonging to the State private domain, necessary for the achievement of its functions.

This transfer takes place in accordance with the legislation in force.

The inventory of the buildings, movable property and material mentioned in the 1<sup>st</sup> sub paragraph of the article herein, is drawn up with a descriptive statement supplied with an estimate worked out by a commission whose members are appointed by joint order of the Minister in charge of State Properties, the Minister in charge of Finance and the Minister in charge of Transport.

The law herein shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Tunisia and implemented as law of the State.

**Law n° 2014-28 dated 19 June 2014, regulating the situation of the soldiers aggrieved by the case called "Barraket Essahel "(1).**

In the name of the People,

The National Constituent Assembly having adopted,

The President of the Republic enacts the following organic law:

Article one - The provisions of the law herein apply to the soldiers aggrieved by the case called "Barrake tEssahel ".

Art. 2 - The provisions of article 2 of the decree-law n° 2011-1 dated 19 February 2011, relating to the amnesty and the articles 32 and 33 of law n° 2012-27 dated 29 December 2012, relating to the appropriations law for the year 2013 and their application texts, are extended to the soldiers mentioned in article one of the law herein, non-covered by the amnesty.

The law herein shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Tunisia and implemented as law of the State.
